C. Introductions

Jeff Schweig gave a presentation on the services he provides to organizations for fingerprinting and background checks. They do live fingerprint scans for approximately \$10 per person. Discussed procedures, documentation required and additional services offered.

E. Reports:

1. President – Mike Bier

- The tournament meeting is set for June 24 and 25.
- All tournaments have been accepted. Check website for update. May 1st was the release date for applications.
- Any event/jamboree must be signed by Mike Bier and Kathy Ayala at District VI if not within our club
- Jamborees can't make money but events can make money.
- Jo Mesa only does comp tournaments. Mary said some select teams sent their information to Jo by mistake.
- Events need to be signed by Mike then Kathy Ayala.

- Three teams are going to Regionals. Two from River City and one from San Juan.
- E/D Course is scheduled in Marysville July 14,15,16 and then 21,22,23.

- The hosting league/club is responsible for all expenses of the coaching course. Generally, the Club and League each pay half of the course fee.

i. El Dorado Competitive Club –Henry Reis

Deferred to Phil's report on the Club's activities.

ii. El Dorado Hills SC – Marc Pearl for Ed Grinnell

- Approximately 1500 kids are registered to date.
- 70% of teams are on-line.
- Registration is technically closed but they are taking kids on a waiting list.

iii. Gold Nugget –Kiley Keeley

Registration is open through June 1st. They will be taking registrations through opening day but charging a \$10 late fee after June 1st.

The Board accepted a proposal by We Print U to provide fingerprinting.

Two select teams have been formed.

iv. High Sierra SC – Greg Danker
